

**TCPI: Support and Alignment Network**  
**Idaho Primary Care Association: *The Center for Healthcare Transformation***

The Idaho Primary Care Association (IPCA) at the request of the Idaho Healthcare Coalition (the Coalition) is creating the Center for Healthcare Transformation (the Center). The Center will identify and create opportunity, and execute strategy aligning Idaho stakeholders for effectiveness and efficiency in the transforming of health care in Idaho.

The Governor appointed the Coalition to advise all State efforts, public and private, around healthcare transformation. The Coalition is comprised of physicians, payers (commercial, Medicaid, and Medicare), advocates, purchasers, and State leadership. The Coalition asked the IPCA to lead this effort, and further requested Coalition members Idaho Medical Association, Idaho Academy of Family Physicians, and Idaho Department of Health and Welfare to join the effort. Coalition parameters include: (a) align Idaho stakeholders for effectiveness and efficiency, (b) plan and execute operational activities arising from the Coalition and other transformational efforts, and (c) make national and state transformation efforts relevant to the daily work flows and professional lives of all Idaho clinicians and practices. This SAN proposal focuses on the third parameter: enabling all Idaho clinicians to effectively receive and integrate change by informing, educating and training through familiar and accepted means. In effect, a grass roots effort for all Idaho clinicians.

The project will establish the Resource Center, a one-stop connecting hub for transformation assistance and information, which will include a well-promoted web library and QI Advisors to share information, provide linkage, and provide direct assistance to clinicians and practice administrators. The project will include a physician champion to enhance clinician engagement in transformational change.

The project will support PTNs operating in Idaho, or operating in areas impacting Idaho. The project will interface and actively participate in national TCPI efforts. The project will also work with the recently funded Idaho SIM program. The project will integrate and spread TCPI, other best practice, PTN, SIM, payer, health system, HRSA, and other content to clinicians, using trusted communication, education, CME, and CPE systems.

The project will provide a venue for aligning now disconnected transformational efforts. The project will work to create a single language of transformation for Idaho, and to align TCPI/PTN and SIM messaging and activities to improve efficiency and reduce complexity for providers. The project will attempt to create a single brand identity for Idaho transitional work, including the work of TCPI projects, SIM and the Coalition, payer initiatives, and system initiatives and will inform providers, patients, payers, purchasers and other stakeholders on the relationship between practice transformation dimensions and the triple aim.

This SAN accepts as its target all Idaho clinicians - physicians, nurse practitioners, and physician assistants. This target includes an estimated 4,385 clinicians. The SAN will also work with other team members (e.g., nurses, pharmacists) and practice administrators.

Funding requested for the four-year project period is \$2,942,951.
